**Travel insurance will be available with an Asheville Sister Cities membership.**



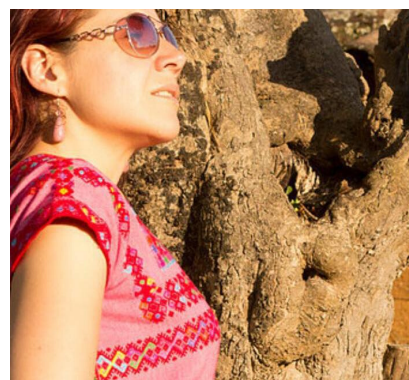
**MUSEO JTATIK SAMUEL**
